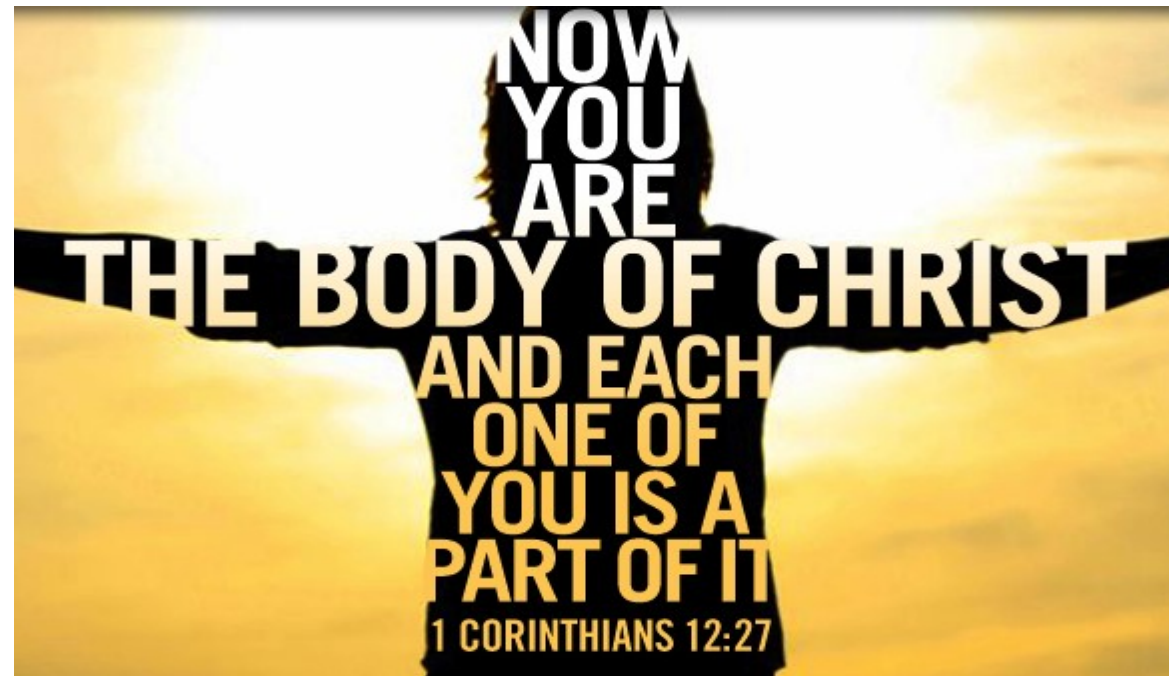
CALLING ALL GRADS!!
