CHILDCARE / NURSERY COORDINATOR NEEDED

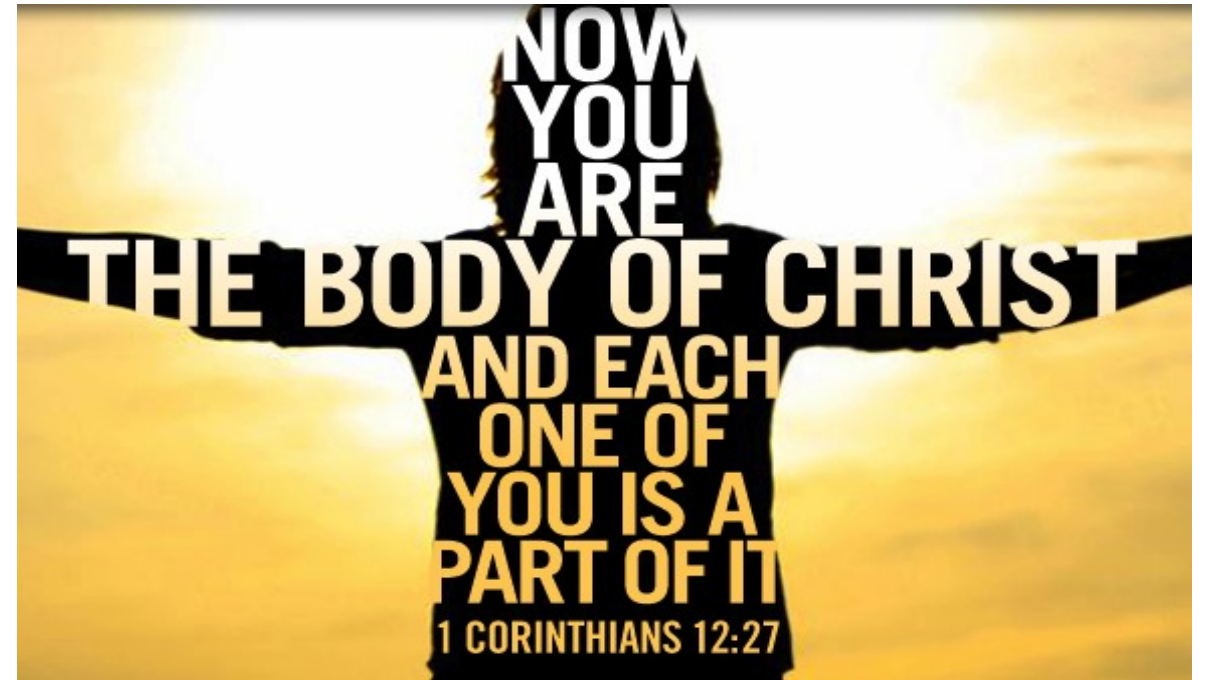
