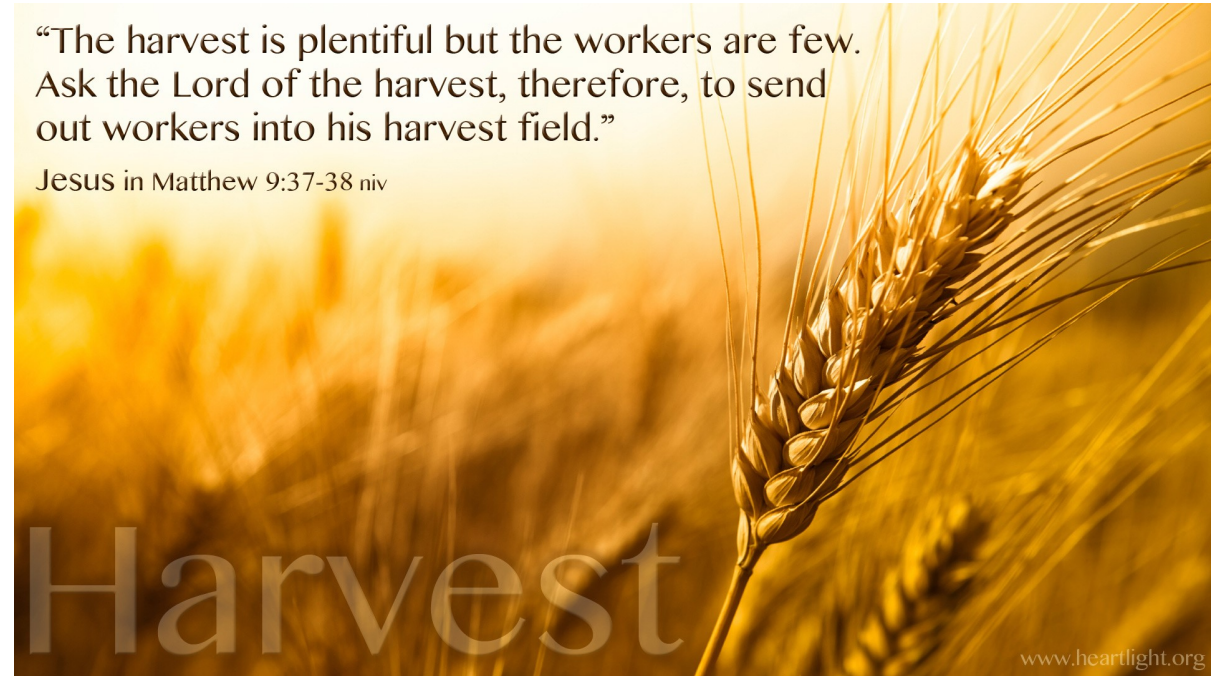
**DONATIONS FOR CARD MINISTRY**
